Real Wood

Oak This extremely popular hardwood features a unique blend of strength and enduring beauty. Wood patterns will vary, as will the colors, ranging from warm, soft browns to near white. The variety of grains and the proper stain results in an eye-pleasing color gradation throughout the cabinet.

Cherry For a look of elegance and luxury, cherry cabinets are unmatched. This solid hardwood possesses rich hues that vary from light red to deep reddish brown. Known for its fine, tight grain patterns, cherry will take stain exceptionally well and will darken over time with exposure to light.

Hickory An open-grained wood that offers a wide range of color possibilities, hickory provides a truly distinctive look. Grain patterns can be bold and irregular, while color can range from white to chocolate. Hickory's strength and shock resistance allow it to withstand rigorous daily use.

Maple The clean simplicity of maple doors makes them the ideal choice for either contemporary and traditional decor. An exceptionally strong and heavy wood, maple is characterized by its white or creamy color. It features even, closely spaced grain with burls, pin knots, mineral streaks and tiger stripes to add to its unique personality. Maple doors provide a smooth, radiant look when finished with a light stain.

Definitions

- 1. Bore The drilling of 35mm hole for hidden European cup hinge.
- 2. Bore Left (BL) Looking at the front of the door the bore holes are on the left side of the door.
- 3. Bore Right (BR) Looking at the front of the door the bore holes are on the right side of the door.
- 4. Bore Pair (BP) The boring of two doors covering one opening, one bored left and one bored right.
- **5.** Hanger Holes Two small 1/8" diameter holes drilled in the back side of the door, to hang the door while the finish is applied.
- **6.** Frame Only (FO) A door without a center panel prepared for glass or other inserts.
- 7. Mullion Door A frame-only door with cross pieces. Made to look like panes of glass.
- **8.** End Panels Material used to cover the ends of your cabinets. Usually 3/16 plywood of the same color or a matching door with a 115 edge.


- **9.** Accent Glazing The process of adding a contrasting color Vanilla (white), Mocha (medium brown) or Licorice (dark brown) to the face of the door on the edge profiles and panel profile. Glazed finishes are applied and wiped by hand for a unique, handcrafted look and no two doors or drawer fronts are identical.
- 10. RTF Rigid Thermal Foil a high quality PVC which is fused, using computer-controlled heat and pressure, to a MDF (medium density fiberwood) panel giving you the look of paint with a surface many times tougher.
- 11. SAC Self Adhesive Covering used to cover the face frame of your cabinets. Comes in real wood or RTF and in the same colors as your doors and is intended to blend. As a rule order one sheet for every ten doors. Do not use SAC to cover the ends of your cabinets. SAC will not adhere to raw wood.
- 12. Frameless Cabinets A cabinet box made typically from 3/4" or 5/8" material without a frame attached to the front of the box.








Valances

Use valances to create borders or join cabinets for a seamless appearance that enhances the visual integrity of your kitchen. When used in conjunction with our stylish, handcrafted moulding, the result is uniquely elegant.



Matching Shelves & Brackets

Add functionality to your kitchen with these decorative 9" x 9" matching brackets and shelf up to 12" deep. On the order form under options, enter shelf with edge profile. One long edge of shelf will be square.

Self-Adhesive Covering





Comes in real wood and Rigid Thermal Foil (RTF) 24" x 96". As a rule order 1 sheet for every 10 doors. Do not apply SAC to your end panels. Order a door or cut-to-size plywood. SAC will

end panels. Order a door or cut-to-size plywood. SAC will not adhere to raw wood. Any raw wood must be sealed with spray adhesive or varnish.

FAQs

Can I order the veneer before I order the doors?

This is not recommended - The first step in installation is to make sure all items blend. You should lay out all doors, drawer fronts and accessories and check for the correct color blend and accuracy of the order.

Do mullion doors come with glass?

No, however the doors are prepared for glass. We recommend using clear silicone caulk.

Do doors come with hinges installed?

No, the hinges are boxed separately with the order and come with installation instructions.

Wood Description

Quality Doors uses finishes that protect and enhance the natural beauty of wood. Extra care is taken to assure a uniform finish. Because we are dedicated to customer satisfaction we feel that it is important to explain some of the characteristics of Quality Doors finishes on hardwood. Like fingerprints, characteristic differences in color and grain are produced by nature in every tree. These variations are what create the beauty and interest found in wood. The variations in color, grain and texture will cause variations in the finish, even though identical finishing processes are applied. These variations are considered a natural characteristic of hardwood and are not a defect. We hope that you will appreciate and enjoy this beauty.

Photos in the catalog depicting color and samples on our display represent the general color, tone and grain of our doors. Actual orders may vary from the photos and display samples due to the difference in the natural characteristics of real wood. Colors of accessory items are designed to blend with doors and drawer fronts. Our doors are not designed to match your existing cabinets because of wood variation and the natural aging process of your existing cabinets. The only way to assure the proper blend between the doors and your cabinets is to order doors and drawer fronts, veneer (SAC), and accessories at the same time.

LIMITED WARRANTY

Quality Doors warrants all standard products for one year from the date of shipment against warpage to these tolerances: Doors: Raised panel doors less than 23" in width and 46" in height are warranted against warpage of more than 1/8". Frames and plywood insert panel doors less than 23" in width and 46" in height are warranted against warpage of more than 1/4". Doors more than 23" in width and/or 46" in height are not warranted. Drawer fronts: Drawer fronts less than eight inches in height and 24" in width are warranted against warpage of more than 1/4". Drawer fronts more than 12" in height (across the grain) or 30" in width (with the grain) are not warranted. Warranty: Warranty covers replacement of door and shipping only. Quality Doors assumes no responsibility for damage, other than warpage, incurred by the customer during storage, handling or the finishing process. All claims for shortages or damage must be made within 10 days of receipt. Due to the natural characteristics of wood, metal, vinyl and stains, all items will not match exactly. Example: Real wood will not match RTF SAC exactly. Items are manufactured to blend in colors and textures. Display sample colors may vary slightly from actual product received.
